The retreat will use the camp's Lodge, a comfortable building featuring group meeting areas, kitchen, and recreational rooms on the first floor and hotel-like rooms, each with a connecting bath, on the second floor. We will use the Red Pine Center (next door) for meals, worship, and group activities.

Bring a spirit of awe and adventure, as you spend some time away from the "cares of the world", relaxing and nourishing your body, mind, and soul in this quiet and

beautiful setting along Fish Hook Lake and under towering pines. During the week, there will be time for discussion, using Matt Rawle's study, *"The Gift of the Nutcracker"*; time for worship; time to enjoy the beauty of the area and the display of fall colors. During the afternoons, there will be time to explore the area and take part in several options for relaxation--golf, fish, bike, enjoy a hammock under the pines along the beach, take a boat ride, read a book, commune with nature, even take a nap.
