What happens when I get to camp?

Arrival and Registration:

Plan to arrive at camp between 3-4 PM for your check-in. Our staff will welcome you and give further instruction when you arrive. We will collect necessary paperwork, spending money, and any remaining fees. You will also get to meet the camp nurse, hand in any medications, and drop off your luggage. Then you will head up to your cabin where they'll get to choose a bunk (do you like top or bottom?), meet their counselor & cabin-mates, and get their

Make sure to bring, or have completed on-line, your:

- Medical Information Form,
- Release of Liability,
- COVID-19 Release of Liability

At check-in you'll turn in:

- all Medication,
- any Spending Money

Parents: On the Health Form, please make sure that you list the people authorized to pick up your child (including yourself!). We can not release your camper unless that person's

name is on the Medical Information form and they have a picture ID.

-All medication must be in original containers labeled with name and dosage. Over the counter medication must also be turned in.

- Spending money, paid on-line or in-person, will be deposited in a "camper account" that can be used during camp at the canteen, camp store. Any unspent money will be returned at the end of camp.
