- ▶ We are very excited to have you and your grandchild come to camp this year! Get ready for a week of fun and inspiration together.

Two Weeks Before Camp - Full payment for camp is due. And be sure your **Release of Liability Waiver**, **COVID-19 Release of Liability Waiver** and **Medical Information Forms** have been filled out online. (Or bring them with you to camp - but they are **required** to attend camp)



What happens when I get to camp?

- ▶ Go to Sunrise Inn at Koronis Ministries to check-in.
- ▶ Bring, or have completed on-line, your required forms:
 - Release of Liability
 - COVID-19 Release of Liability
 - Medical Information Form
 - Medications List (if needed)
- ▶ **Adult participants manage their own medications;** please bring what you anticipate needing. **All personal medications, including over-the-counter medications, must be stored securely while attending camp, either discreetly in a locked vehicle or in another secure location.**
- ▶ Grandparents must take responsibility for medications for their grandchildren OR turn them in to the camp nurse.

What will camp be like?

Afternoons are filled with free-time options for you and your grandchild to enjoy: swimming, boating, fishing, nature hikes, game room, pontoon boat, canoeing and more.

Evening activities include campfires, an ice cream social and other special events.

Mornings will kick off with a time of worship and a brief inter-generational meditation in our chapel. Then the kids will be dismissed to enjoy a variety of fun camp activities under the supervision of Camp Koronis counseling staff. Grandparents will have their own morning bible study and discussion sessions. Grandparents will be encouraged to lead a "Bible devotion" at night with their grand-campers.

What do I need to bring?

What to Bring

- Signed Health & Waiver Forms if not completed online
- Medications needed during camp
- Clothing for each day (rainy days too!)
- PJ's
- Jacket or sweatshirt
- Bath towel & washcloth
- Soap, shampoo, toothbrush & toothpaste
- Swimsuit, beach towel, sandals or water shoes
- Bible, notebook & pencil
- Sunscreen & insect repellent
- Tennis shoes or closed toe shoes
- Flashlight
- A mask for each day
- Linens & towels are provided

What to Bring - Optional

- Money for Camp Store (turned in @ check-in)
- Camera
- Hat
- Sunglasses
- Stamps & envelopes

What NOT to bring:

- Pets
- Sports equipment
- Fireworks or lighters
- Extra food, snacks or pop
- Alcohol, tobacco or drugs
- Weapons
- Computers or gaming systems

Other Things to Know:

- ▶ **Health Care:** Limited health-care support is available at camp, although a local clinic/hospital is just a few minutes away.
- ▶ **Waterfront:** Koronis Ministries is located on beautiful Lake Koronis. Swimming and boating are available daily during each afternoon under the direction of our lifeguards. Waterfront activities are only available when guards are on duty.
- ▶ **Accommodations:** GrandCamp participants will stay in Sunrise Inn, in air-conditioned motel-style rooms with two double beds and a private bath.
- ▶ **Emergency Phone:** In case of emergency, call Koronis Ministries at 320-243-4544 or camp director Dan Ziegler's cell phone 612-913-6002.
