Campers:

Congratulations! You are registered for **Mini Horse Camp 1** at Camp Koronis, **July 10-13**. We are very excited you can join us for this week of fun and adventure—and horses! Each morning during your time at camp you and your cabin-mates will spend an hour learning to ride & care for a horse chosen just for you at nearby *Flanders Ranch*. The rest of your time you'll spend at Camp Koronis where you will get to make new friends, swim & boat, explore the forest with your cabin

group, sing & cook-out at the campfire, play group games, and grow in your faith!

IMPORTANT: Specific guidance around COVID-19 protocols at camp, if needed, will be provided prior to the start of your event. Please watch your email for messages from the camping office.

Parents: Our goal is to provide a camp experience that is imaginative, adventurous, and safe for every camper. Our college-age summer staff are people of strong faith and character, carefully vetted & trained with camper's wellbeing in mind. Camp Koronis also holds the distinction of being accredited by the *American Camp Association*, so your camper will experience Christ, Creation & Community in a quality environment.

What happens when I get to camp?

Arrival and Registration:

Plan to arrive at camp between 3-4 PM for your check-in. Our staff will welcome you and give further instruction when you arrive. We will collect necessary paperwork, spending money, and any remaining camp fees at that time. You will also get to meet the camp nurse, hand in any medications, and drop off your luggage. Then you will head up to your cabin where you'll get to choose a bunk (do you like top or bottom bunk?), meet your counselor &

cabin-mates, and get your FREE T-Shirt! Make sure to bring, or have completed on-line, your:

- Medical Information Form,
- Release of Liability,
- COVID-19 Release of Liability

At check-in you'll turn in:

- all Medication,
- any Spending Money

Parents:

On the Health Form, please make sure that you list the people authorized to pick up your child (including yourself!). We can not

release your camper unless that person's name is on the health form and they have a picture ID.

-All medication must be in original containers labeled with name and dosage. Over the counter medication must also be turned in.

-All spending money, paid on-line or in-person, will be deposited in a "camper account" that can be used during camp at the canteen, camp store, or for a special all-camp offering. Any unspent money will be returned at the end of camp.



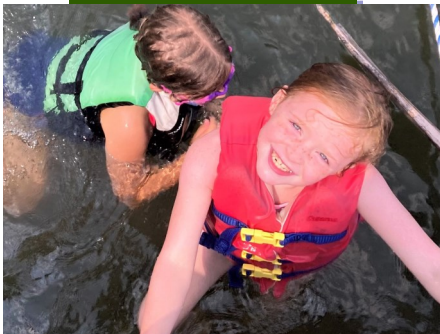
